

The following ordinance was introduced by Mr. Scogin, who moved its adoption, and seconded by Mr. Abney :

ORDINANCE NO. 462

An ordinance to create and form a mosquito abatement district in St. Tammany Parish, Louisiana, to set forth and define its boundaries, to designate its name and number, to designate its domicile, its powers and its commissioners, to provide for its organization, and to designate the officers to be elected by the board of commissioners of said district.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE ST. TAMMANY PARISH POLICE JURY:

SECTION 1. There is hereby formed and created a mosquito abatement district in St. Tammany Parish, Louisiana, to include all of the territory embraced within the Eighth and Ninth Wards of St. Tammany Parish, as presently constituted.

SECTION 2. The mosquito abatement district herein created is hereby named and shall be known as MOSQUITO ABATEMENT DISTRICT NO. 2, PARISH OF ST. TAMMANY, LOUISIANA. Its corporate domicile shall be Slidell, Louisiana, at which domicile it may be sued and service of citation made on the President, and in his absence upon the Vice-President, and in their absence, upon the Secretary.

SECTION 3. The Mosquito Abatement District shall be governed by a board of five to be known as Commissioners, who shall be qualified electors in the district.

SECTION 4. J. V. Burkes and A. G. Woodside, each to serve for a term of two (2) years, and George B. Dunbar, Stanley Weiss and James Keith, each to serve for a term of three (3) years, from the date of this ordinance, are hereby appointed to serve as the first commissioners of said district. Thereafter, all commissioners shall serve for a term of three (3) years. The commissioners of said district shall meet at Slidell, Louisiana, not later than the 19th day of September, 1968, and elect officers as follows:

1. They shall elect from their number a Chairman and a Vice-Chairman. The Chairman shall preside over the meetings of the Board and perform other duties usually required of Chairmen of corporate boards. The Vice-Chairman shall act in the absence of the Chairman.

2. They shall elect a Secretary. The Secretary shall furnish a bond in a sum equal to the amount of taxes collected in the district and the amount of funds otherwise held by or collected by him during any one year. The premium on this bond shall be paid by the district. The Secretary shall perform all of the duties required of him by the Board of Commissioners of the District. The Secretary may also be Treasurer.

3. They shall elect such other officers as may be required.

SECTION 5. The Board of Commissioners of the District shall, at the

time of their organization, select one of the solvent chartered banks within the Parish where the district is organized in which the money of the district shall be deposited.

SECTION 6. The Mosquito Abatement District herein created shall have and enjoy all of the powers, privileges and rights conferred upon such districts by Article VI, Section 11.1 of the Constitution of Louisiana.

SECTION 7. Any action heretofore taken in connection with the formation and organization of Mosquito Abatement District No. 2 is hereby confirmed and ratified and any action taken by said district under the authority conferred by Article VI, Section 11.1 of the Constitution of Louisiana, is hereby ratified and confirmed.

This ordinance having been submitted to a vote, the vote thereon was as follows:
